KEY TRENDS

Here is a snapshot of the key trends that we're seeing in the resources collected.

- The role of the private sector in the general response to COVID-19 and specifically in relation to vaccine distribution continue to be the leading topics of discussion among resources found this month (54% and 41% respectively).
- Reflective of the pandemic stage the world is currently in, fewer articles focused on the private sector's role in the delivery of diagnostics (13%) and therapeutics (11%).
- In relation to health system function, governance (48%) dominates the topic of discussion this month, followed closely by service delivery (37%)

South Africa's private sector plays a key role in the nation's impressive vaccination rate of 26.3% (one of the highest in Sub-Saharan Africa). Read more about Business for South Africa (BS4A), an how organizational structure coordinating the private sector's work with the government for the national COVID-19 vaccination campaign, has mandated all private sector vaccination sites across the country to administer vaccines free of charge, regardless of recipients' insurance status.
