KEY TRENDS

Here is a snapshot of the key trends that we're seeing in the resources collected.

- Majority of articles collected this month refer to the private sector delivery of vaccines (49%) followed by the private sector's role in the general response to COVID-19 including delivery of essential services. (41%).
- As the world focuses on vaccine distribution, fewer articles discussed the role of the private sector in the delivery of of therapeutics (11%) and diagnostics (8%) and PPE (8%).
- Service delivery (60%) continues to be the leading topic of discussion this month (particularly for vaccines) followed by governance (38%).
